# 5 Steps to Become a Girl Scout Troop Leader

#### 1. Sign-up as a troop leader.

- Visit gsema.org/join and follow the steps to register as a Girl Scout member and troop leader.
- Already a Girl Scout member? Log into <u>myGS</u> and "Add a Role".
- Need help? <u>Contact us</u> with any questions!

#### 2. Complete your background check.

• Ensure the safety of our girls by completing your <u>background check</u> after you sign-up as a leader.

#### 3. Start your troop leader training.

- Complete the first part of the leader training, <u>Getting Started in Leadership</u>.
- Start exploring the our <u>volunteer resources page</u> on our website and on GS Learn.
- Connect with council or local support when you need help.

#### 4. Grow Your Troop.

- Invite new youth and adult members to join your troop. Check out our <u>Start a Troop page</u> for invitations to join.
- Identify ways other adults can help support the troop using our <u>Ways to Volunteer Worksheet</u>.

#### 5. Embark on your Girl Scout adventure.

- Meet with your co-leaders and your troop.
