

Outdoor Adventure Encampment Pricing, Tips and Additional Information

Pricing for encampments greater than 45 girls:

\$15 per girl for Boating, Archery, Low Ropes

\$20 per girl for High Ropes, Outdoor Climbing Wall, Indoor Climbing Wall, Indoor High Ropes

\$75 per hour for Lifeguards, maximum 50 swimmers at a time

Archery Ranges can be rented for \$50 per 2-hour time block. Archery must be supervised by someone with a USA Archery Level 1 Instructor certification or higher. All equipment will be available for the instructor.

Waterfronts can be rented for \$50 per 2-hour time block. Waterfronts can be rented and the supervision of swimming requires a certified waterfront lifeguard and adult watchers (Lifeguard ratio is 1:25 swimmers with 2 volunteer watchers). Maximum of 50 swimmers at any given time allowed. All needed equipment will be available for lifeguard(s).

Canoes can be rented for 2 hours at a time for the cost of \$50 per 2-hour time block. All canoeing activities must have a minimum of two volunteers present. One volunteer must be a certified instructor/qualified leader with Canoe Certification. A second volunteer with First Aid and CPR certification should also be present.

All activities are rain or shine. If you wish to reschedule due to weather, you must notify the Outdoor Adventure Manager by 12:00 PM the day before the scheduled activity.

You will receive confirmation of your date and times when facilitators have been secured for your program. Please understand we work with part-time facilitators with varying schedules. *We do our very best to meet your date requests, but some dates are harder to fill than others. If your request cannot be fulfilled, we will contact you at least 2 weeks before your requested date to talk about alternatives or offer you a full refund.*

TIPS:

- We start planning for our spring season at the beginning of March. If you complete the request by the end of February we can include your facilitator request in our large email out to our part-time staff for the spring season work opportunities.
- Check online for council programs happening the same weekend of your encampment. There may be other programs going on at your site that your girls could register for. This will also tell you that there may not be as many facilitators available that weekend if there are multiple programs happening at other sites
