Work with and care for a group of campers and help plan and implement a varied, safe, well-rounded program. Support, schedule and supervise Unit Counselors.

Lead Unit Counselor-

Travel: Mentor staff and work with a group of campers to plan and implement a safe, individualized, and well-rounded camp program. Safely facilitate off-camp trips for campers of various ages and abilities that include camper choice, creativity, program specific activities, and are based on an age appropriate continuum.

Leadership Program

Director: Manage and coordinate development of the Girl Scout Program in camp through the promotion and implementation of activities which will provide progressive learning experiences for the campers. Responsible for implementing and leading the Counselor in Training (CIT) program.

Program Counselor: Assist all units in camp to plan, and implement a varied, safe, individualized, well rounded program that is consistent with the Girl Scout program and mission.

Program Counselor -

Adventure: Work with a group of campers to plan and implement a safe, individualized, and well-rounded camp program. Safely facilitate high and low ropes course activities and initiatives to campers of various ages and abilities.

Program Counselor -

Archery: Work with a group of campers to plan and implement a safe, individualized, and well-rounded camp program. Oversee the archery program and maintain equipment.

Program Counselor - Arts

& Crafts: Work with a group of campers to plan and implement a safe, individualized, and well-rounded camp program. Safely facilitate arts and crafts projects and activities for campers of various ages and abilities that include camper choice, creativity, and expression and are based on an age appropriate continuum.

Program Counselor -

Campcraft: Work with a group of campers to plan and implement a safe, individualized, and well-rounded camp program.

Safely facilitate campcraft activities that include hatchet throwing, jack knives, and knot tying to campers of various ages and abilities. Oversee the wood yard and maintain equipment.

Program Counselor-

Health & Wellness: Assist in managing the general health and safety of all campers and staff and give care within certification guidelines.

Program Counselor -

Kitchen: Assist the Head Cook and Assistant Cook in daily meal preparation and kitchen operation.

Program Counselor -

Leadership: Assist in the implementing and leading of the CIT (Counselor in Training) programs. Assist all units in camp to plan and implement a varied, safe, individualized, well rounded program that is consistent with the Girl Scout program and mission.

Program Counselor -

Nature & Science: Direct and coordinate nature and science programs that will provide a progressive learning experience for all campers.

Program Counselor -

Sailing: Work with a group of campers to plan and implement a safe, individualized, and well-rounded camp program. Teach campers of various ages and abilities how to sail.
