Tip! <u>Download</u> and use the new Campanion app (Android and Apple compatible) to easily submit the above forms through your phone.

If your camper's physical is after May 1, in order to get the camp water bottle sticker, you must email <u>Customer Care</u> to inform them of the upcoming physical date and submit your prior year's physical. If you have already email us, thank you.

Important update! Please read the new cancellation procedures carefully.

- Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable to siblings or other sessions/programs.
- Full refunds of camp fees minus the non-refundable deposit may only be made when Customer Care (<u>customercare@gsema.org</u>) is emailed a cancellation request before May 1, 2025.
- For a **50% refund** of camp minus the non-refundable deposit, Customer Care needs to be emailed **before June 1, 2025**.
- Cancellation requests received after June 1, 2025 will not be refunded, regardless of whether that session has a waitlist.
- No refunds are given for campers arriving late, leaving early, dismissed, or unable to attend all or part of a session.

June 3 is when final camp payments are due!

- If there is an outstanding balance on June 3, your default credit card, debit card, or eCheck account will be charged. Please make sure your card or account has sufficient funds for that final payment.
- Check your balance, make a payment, and update your payment method by going to Financial Management in your <u>CampInTouch</u> account.
